Single A (Rookies) Game Rules

Game Times Approx. 1 Hour

1. Pitching

- All pitching and catching will be done by coaches
- There are no balls and strikes. A player remains at bat until they put the ball in play.
- The batting team's coach will pitch to their own team
- Home team provides game ball (some leagues use different balls; you will use the type of ball used by the home team)

2. Batting

- Each team will have a “universal” batting order and the entire team will bat.
- Once the entire team bats, the batting team will take the field.
- Once a player puts the ball in play, they will advance one base at a time.

3. Base running

- Once a ball is put in play (unless a ball is hit far in the outfield) each runner on base will only advance one base at a time.
- Once the last batter of an inning puts the ball in play, that player along with all baserunners will round the bases and touch home plate.
- There is no leading or stealing

4. Fielding

- There should be at least one coach in the field with the players to coach them in the field.
- Although there are no outs recorded, coaches should assist players in making the correct play for the situation.
- Players may be spaced throughout the infield to maximize exposure to hit balls. It is not necessary to man the outfield.
